21	PARTIES		
22	1. Benjamin Bodea (Complainant) is the Executive Officer of the Acupuncture Board		
23	(Board). He brought this action solely in his official capacity and is represented in this matter by		
24	Xavier Becerra, Attorney General of the State of California, by Robert W. Lincoln, Deputy		
25	Attorney General.		
26	2. Woong Soo Jeon, L.Ac. (Respondent) is represented in this proceeding by attorney		
27	Matthew Sheena, Esq., Garmo & Garmo, LLP, whose address is: 124 W Main St Ste 200		
28	El Cajon, CA 92020.		
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3. On or about February 22, 2007, the Board issued Acupuncturist License No. 11565 to Woong Soo Jeon, L.Ac. (Respondent). The Acupuncturist License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 1A-2018-171 and will expire on December 31, 2020, unless renewed.

#### **JURISDICTION**

4. Accusation No. 1A-2018-171 was filed before the Board, and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on October 24, 2019. Respondent timely filed his Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy of Accusation No. 1A-2018-171 is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference.

# **ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS**

- 5. Respondent has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 1A-2018-171. Respondent also has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order.
- 6. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to present evidence and to testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
- 7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and every right set forth above.

## **CULPABILITY**

8. Respondent does not contest that, at an administrative hearing, complainant could establish a prima facie case with respect to the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 1A-2018-171, and that he has thereby subjected his Acupuncture License No. to disciplinary action.

9. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation he enables the Board to issue an order accepting the surrender of his Acupuncturist License without further process.

#### **CONTINGENCY**

- approval by the Executive Officer on behalf of the Board. The parties agree that this Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order shall be submitted to the Executive Officer for his consideration in the above-entitled matter and, further, that the Executive Officer shall have a reasonable period of time in which to consider and act on this Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order after receiving it. By signing this stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Board may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent or his counsel. By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- shall be null and void and not binding upon the parties unless approved and adopted by the Executive Officer on behalf of the Board, except for this paragraph, which shall remain in full force and effect. Respondent fully understands and agrees that in deciding whether or not to approve and adopt this Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, the Executive Officer and/or the Board may receive oral and written communications from its staff and/or the Attorney General's Office. Communications pursuant to this paragraph shall not disqualify the Executive Officer, the Board, any member thereof, and/or any other person from future participation in this or any other matter affecting or involving Respondent. In the event that the Executive Officer on behalf of the Board does not, in his discretion, approve and adopt this Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, with the exception of this paragraph, it

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1	shall not become effective, shall be of no evidentiary value whatsoever, and shall not be relied
2	upon or introduced in any disciplinary action by either party hereto. Respondent further agrees
3	that should this Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order be rejected for any reason
4	by the Executive Officer on behalf of the Board, Respondent will assert no claim that the
5	Executive Officer, the Board, or any member thereof, was prejudiced by its/his/her review,
6	discussion and/or consideration of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order or
7	of any matter or matters related hereto.
8	ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS
9	12. The Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order is intended by the parties
10	herein to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final and exclusive embodiment of
11	the agreements of the parties in the above-entitled matter.
12	13. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile
13	copies of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, including PDF and
14	facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as originals.
15	14. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
16	the Board may, without further notice or formal proceedings, issue and enter the following order
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#### **ORDER**

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Acupuncturist License No. 11565, issued to Respondent Woong Soo Jeon, L.Ac., is surrendered and accepted by the Board.

- 1. The surrender of Respondent's Acupuncturist License and the acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent's license history with the Board.
- 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as an Acupuncturist in California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.
- 3. Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Board his pocket license and, if one was issued, his wall certificate on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.
- 4. If Respondent ever files an application for licensure or a petition for reinstatement in the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a petition for reinstatement. Respondent must comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for reinstatement of a revoked or surrendered license in effect at the time the petition is filed, Respondent does not contest that, at an administrative hearing, complainant could establish a prima facie case with respect to the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 1A-2018-171 and that he has thereby subjected his Acupuncture License No. 11565 to disciplinary action, when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the petition.
- 5. Respondent shall pay the agency its costs of investigation and enforcement in the amount of \$16,023.75 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.
- 6. If Respondent should ever apply or reapply for a new license or certification, or petition for reinstatement of a license, by any other health care licensing agency in the State of California, all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation, No. 1A-2018-171 shall be deemed to be true, correct, and admitted by Respondent for the purpose of any Statement of Issues or any other proceeding seeking to deny or restrict licensure.
