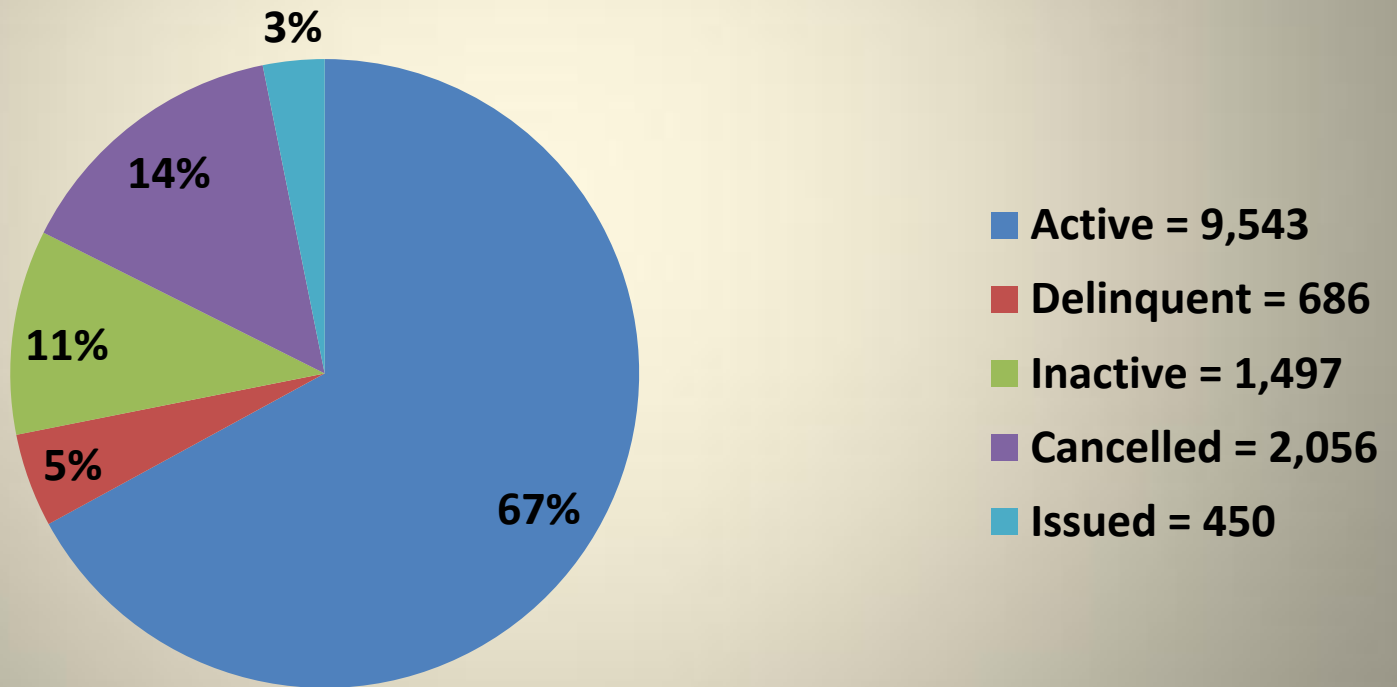

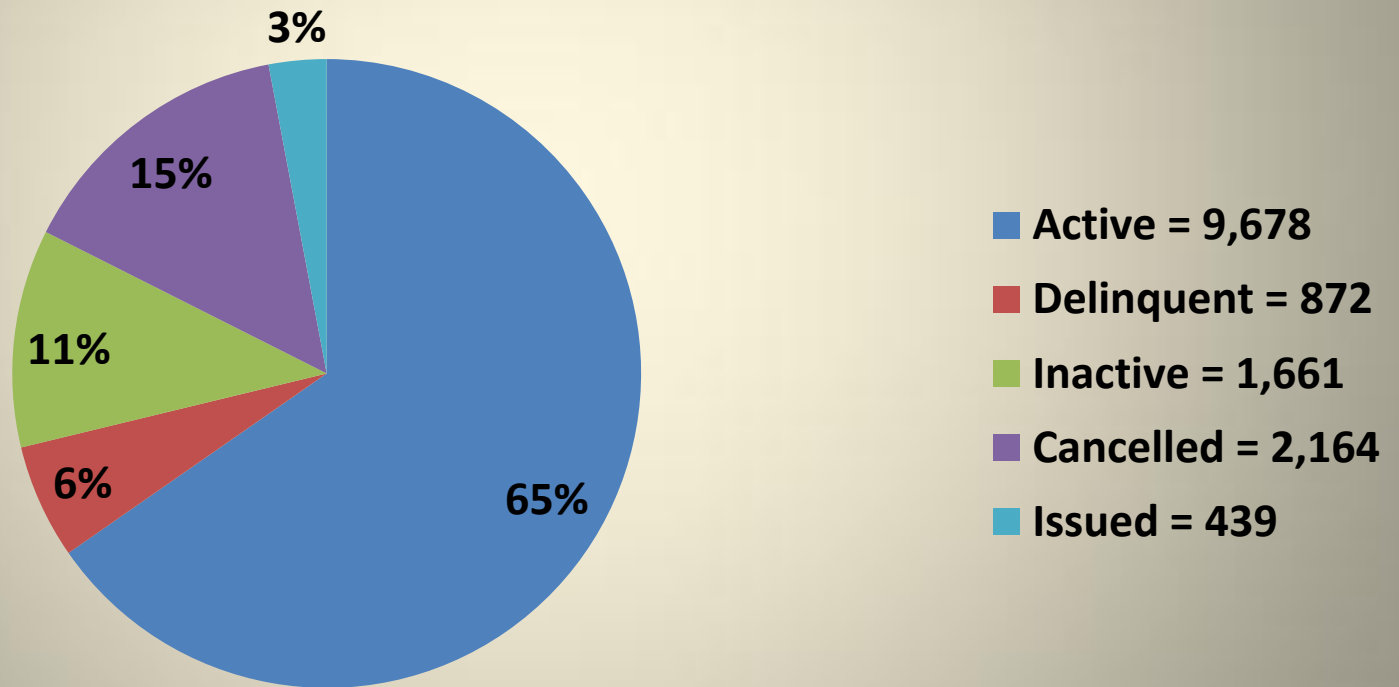

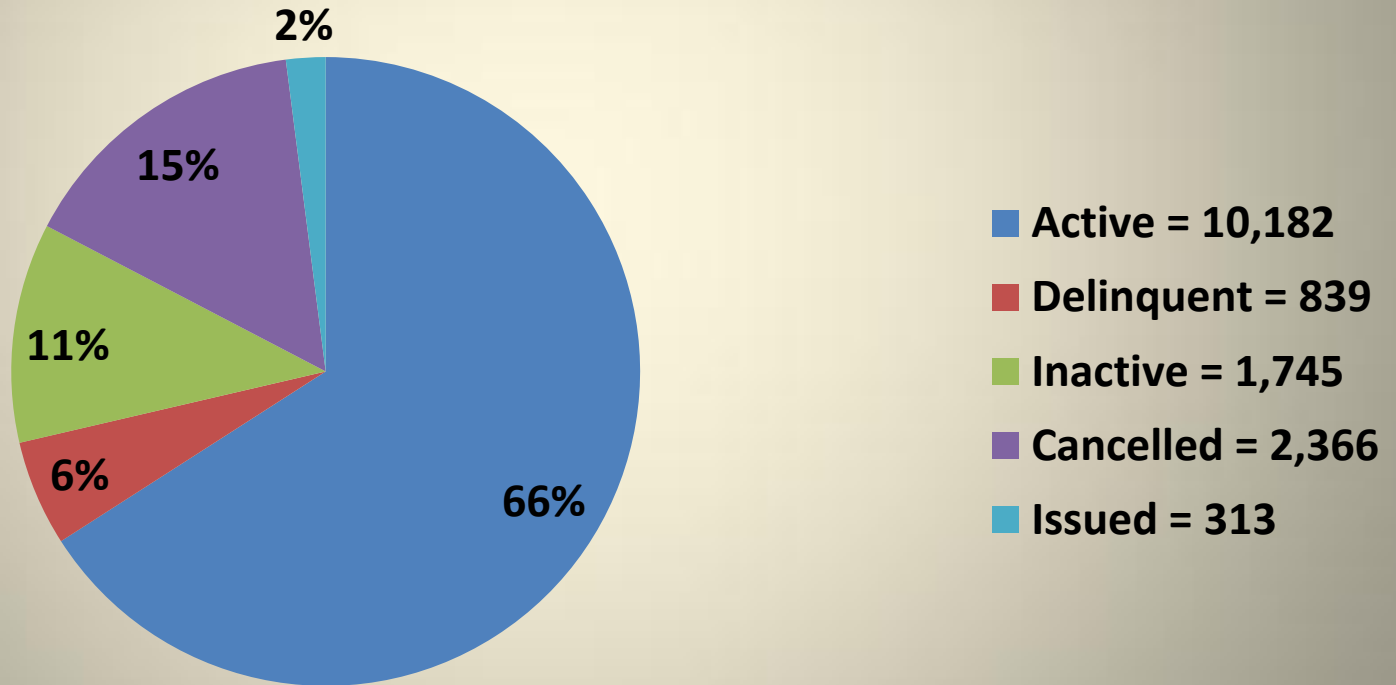
# California Licensees 2010

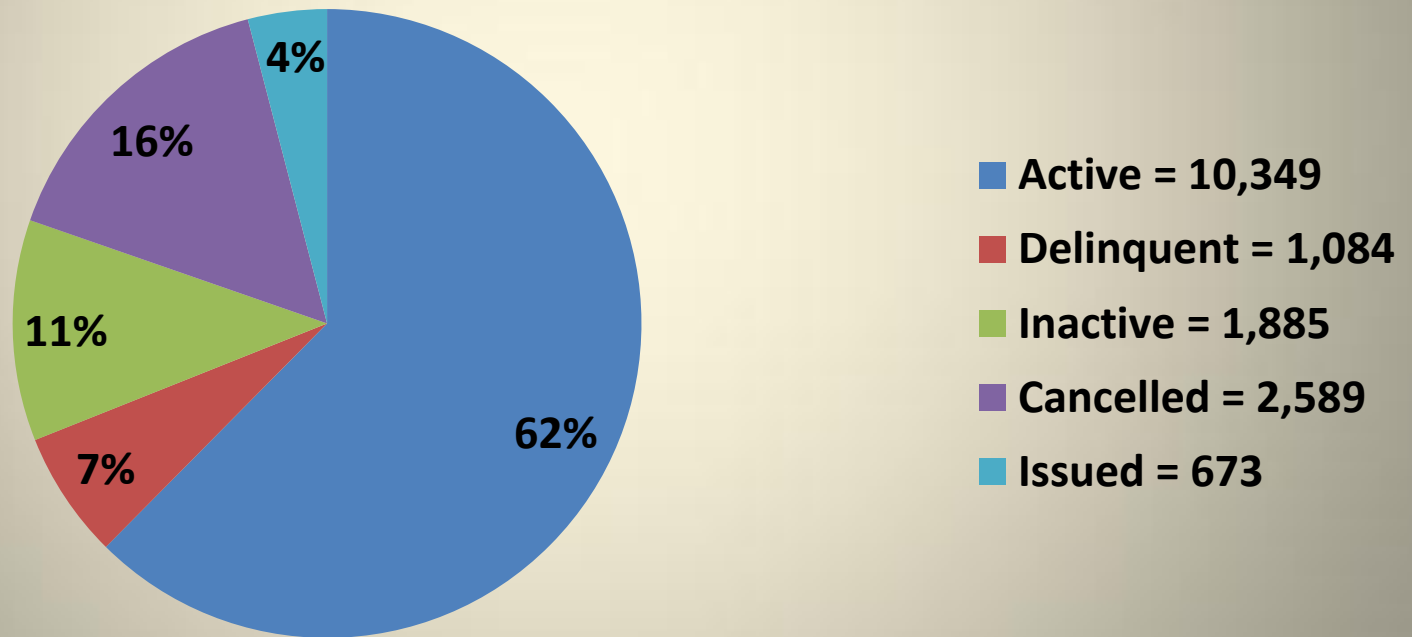
# California Total Licensees 2011

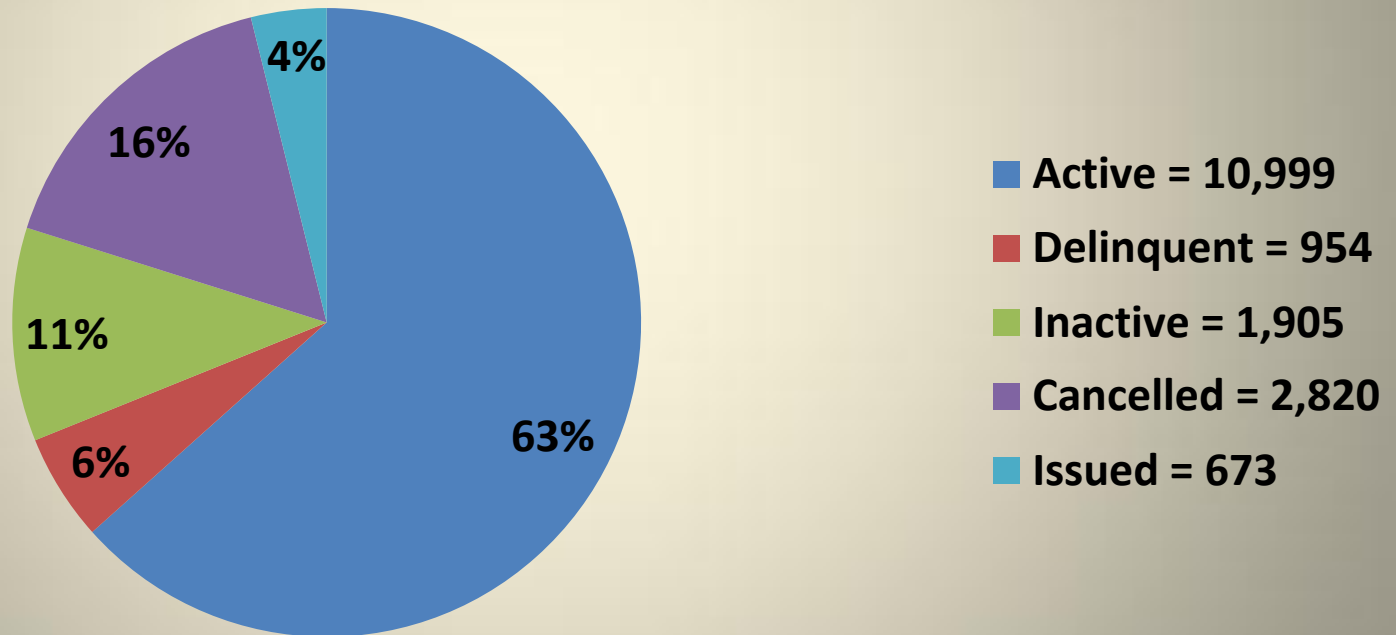

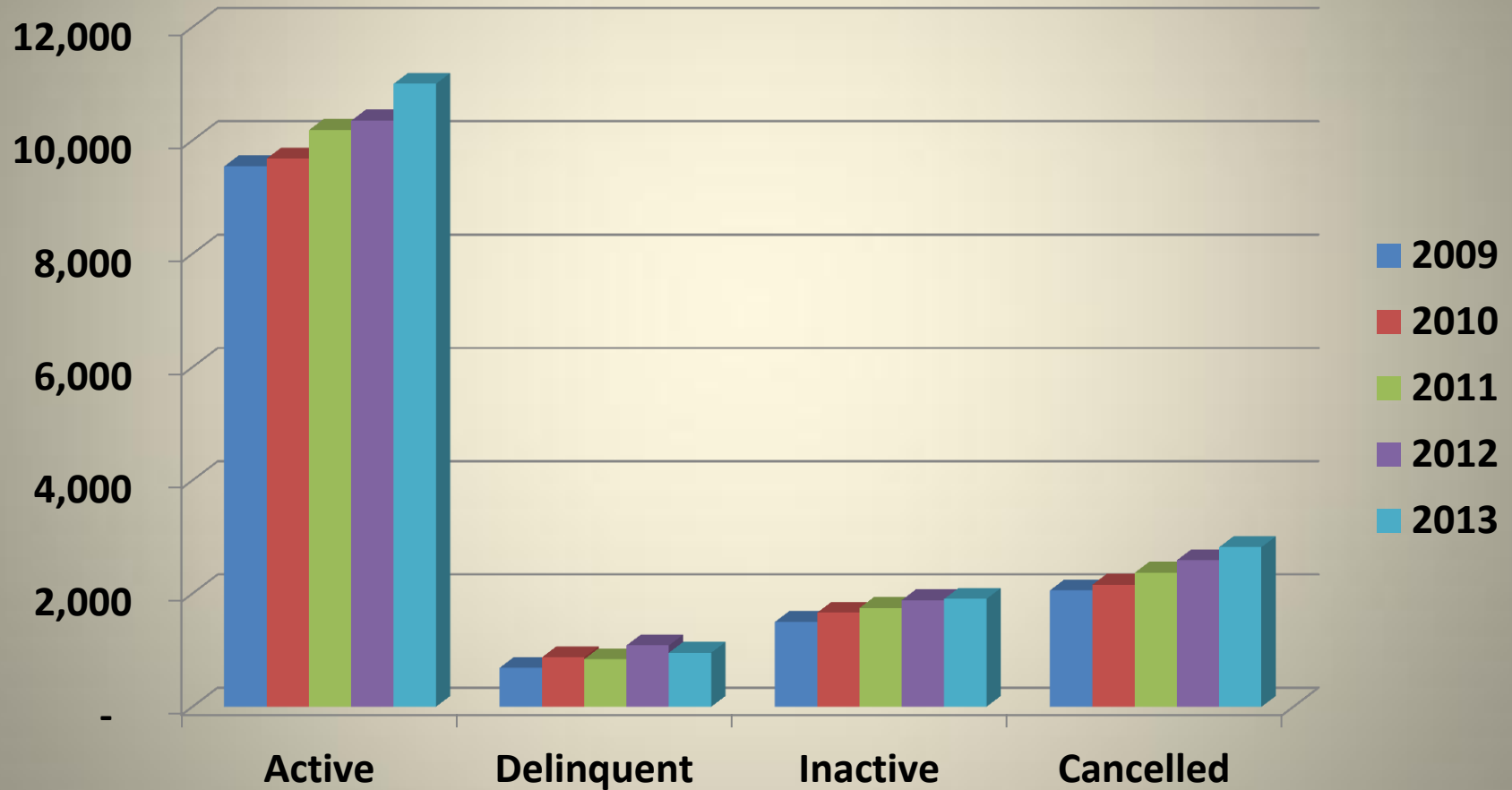

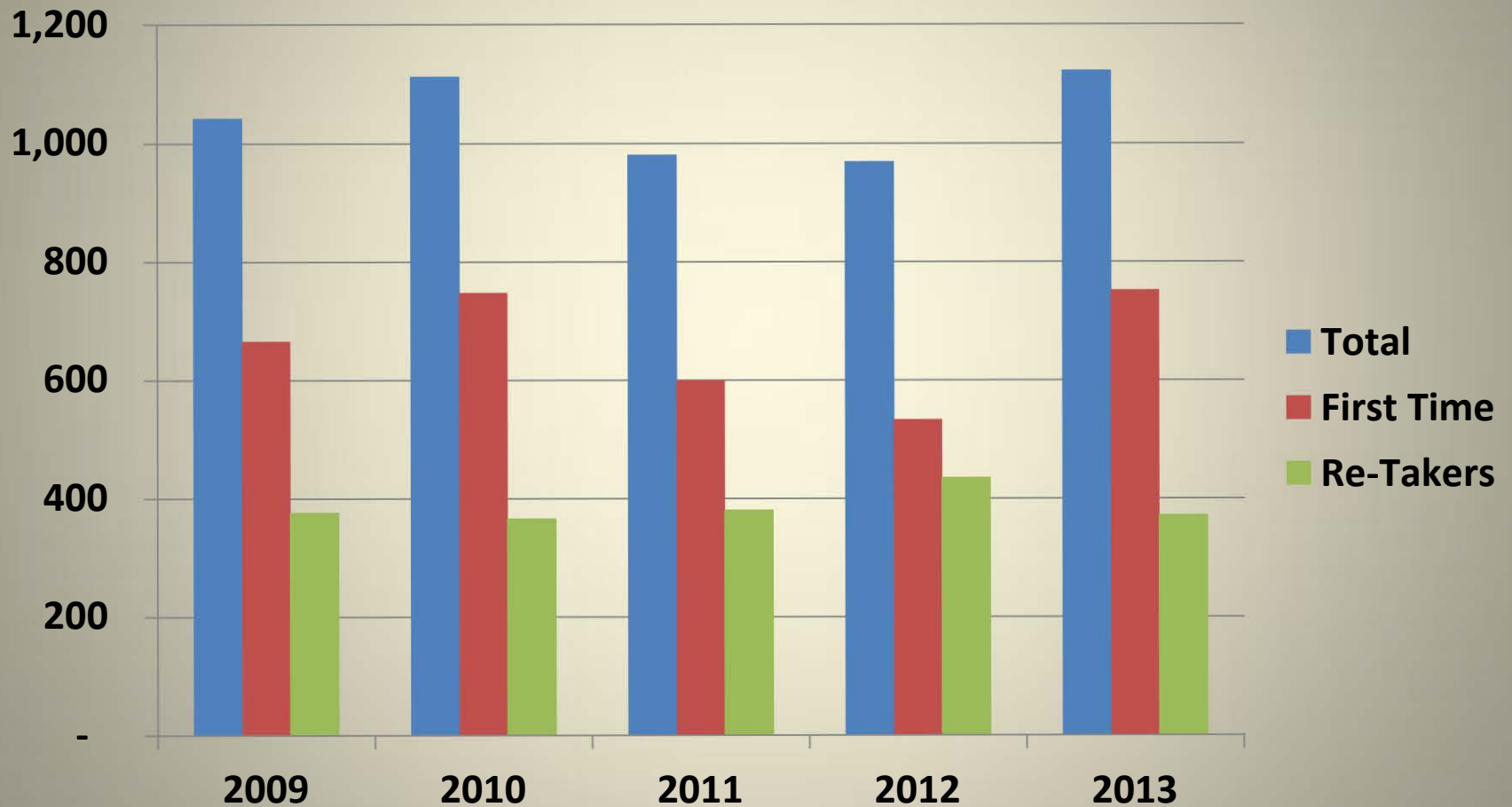

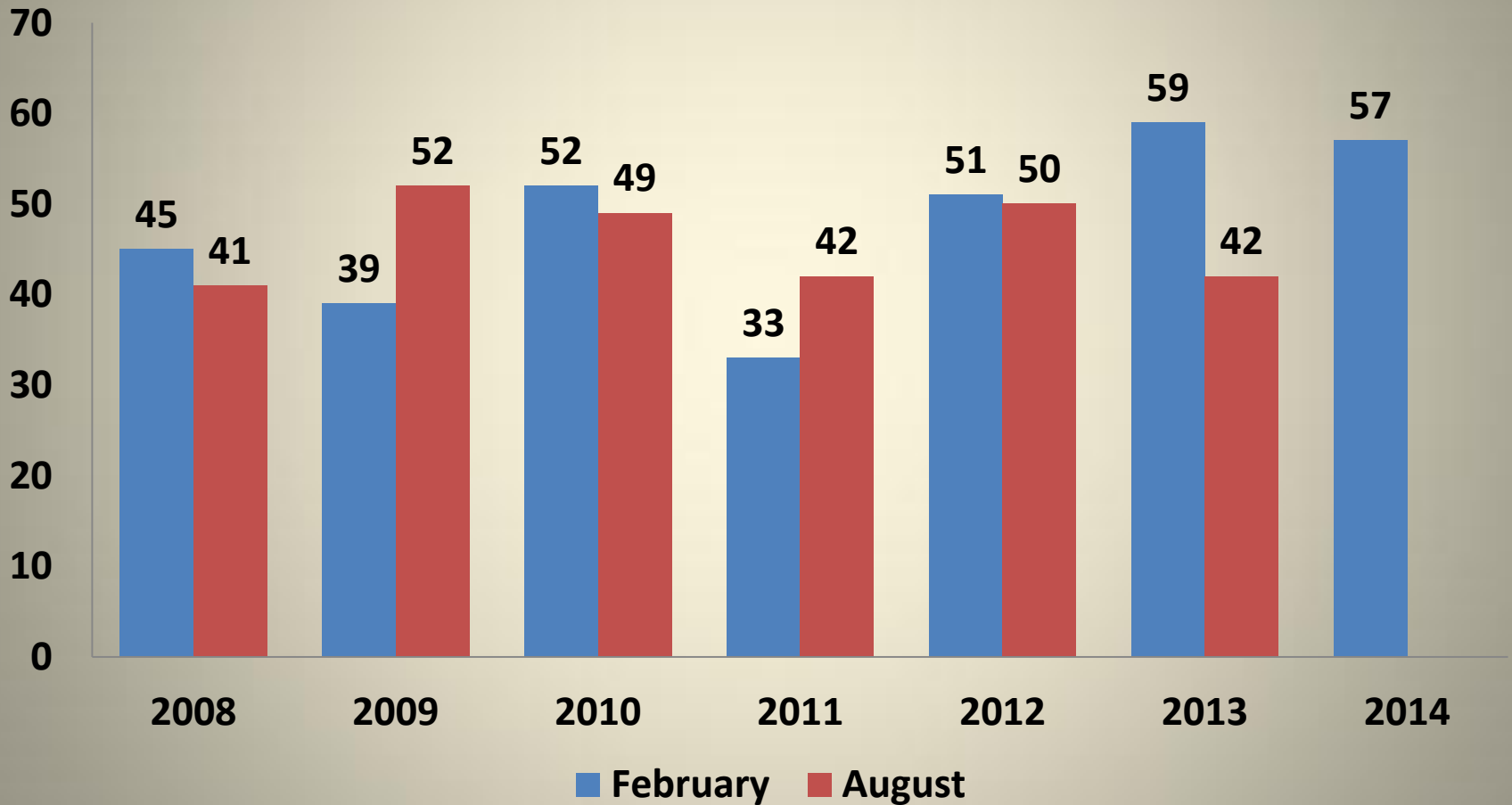

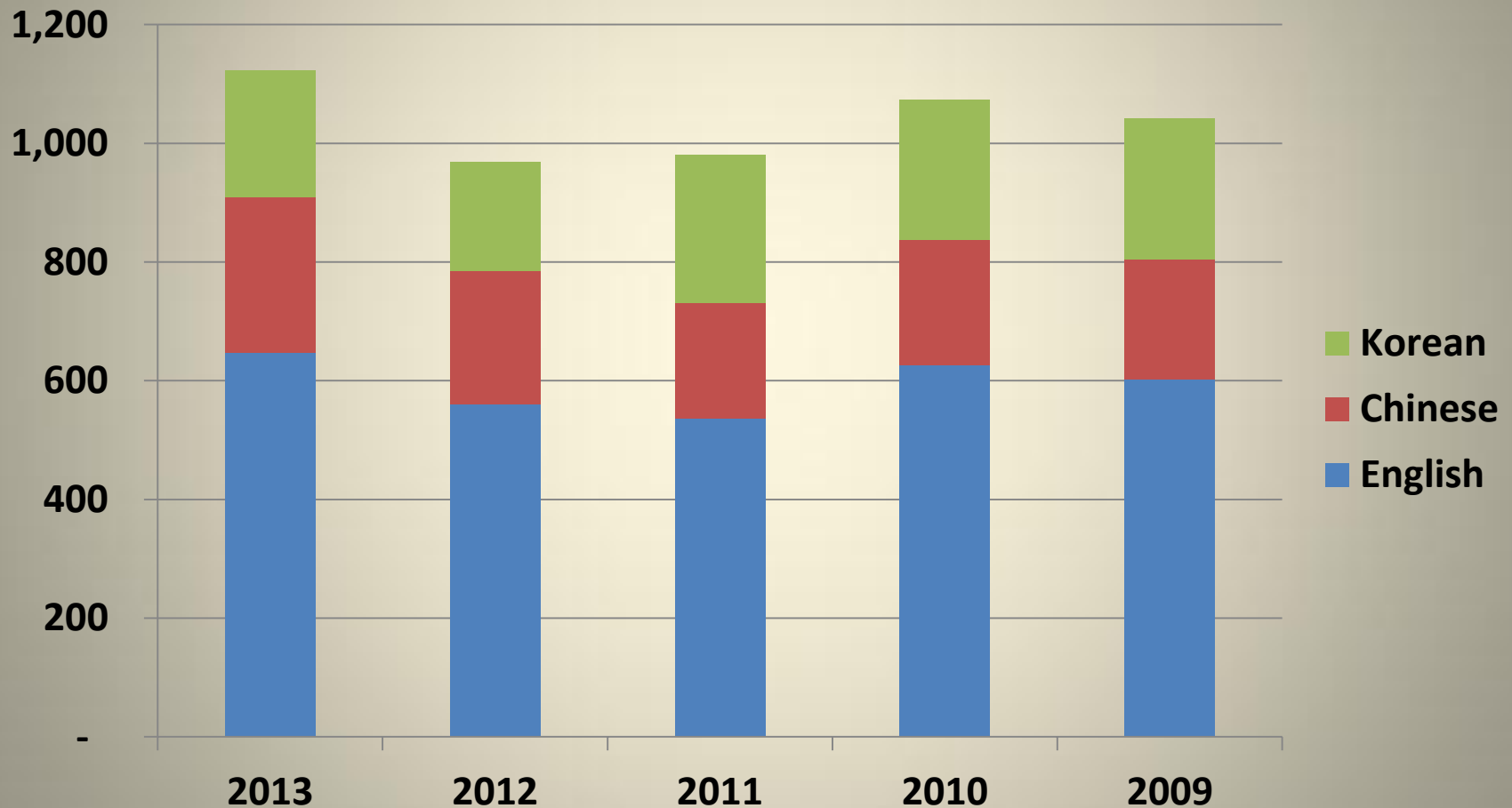

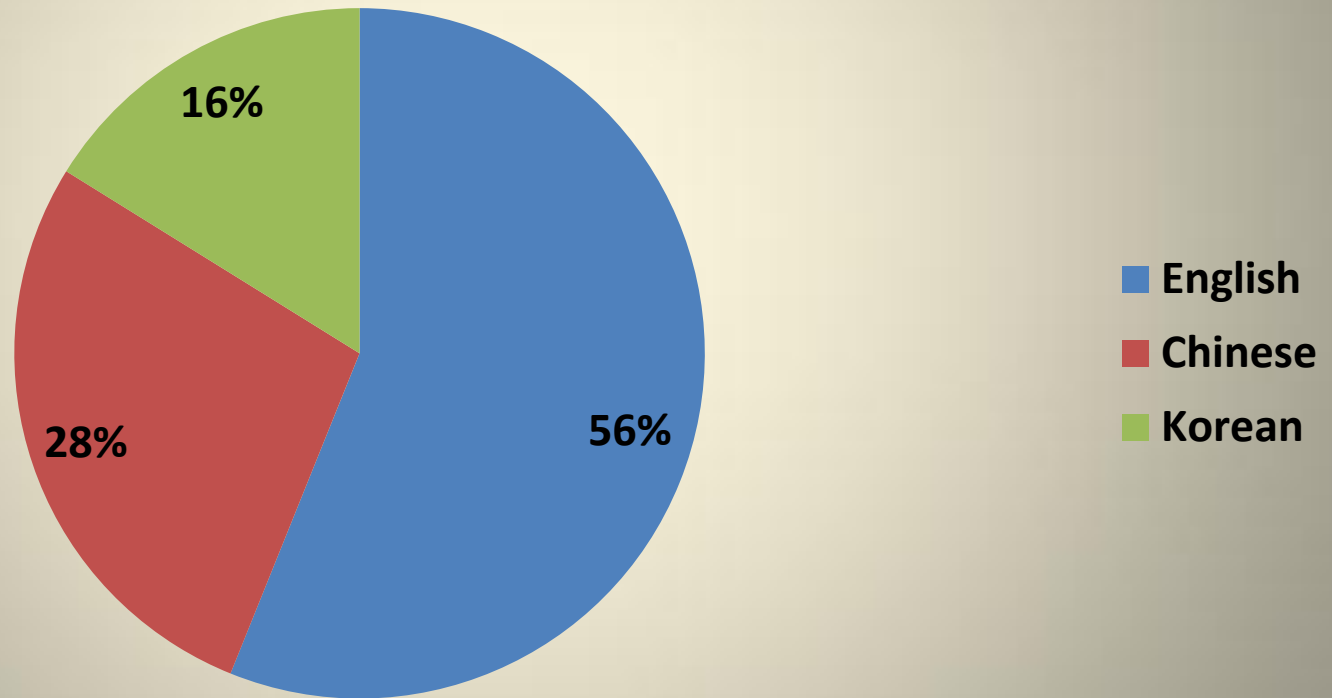


# CALE Test Takers by Language 2009-2013

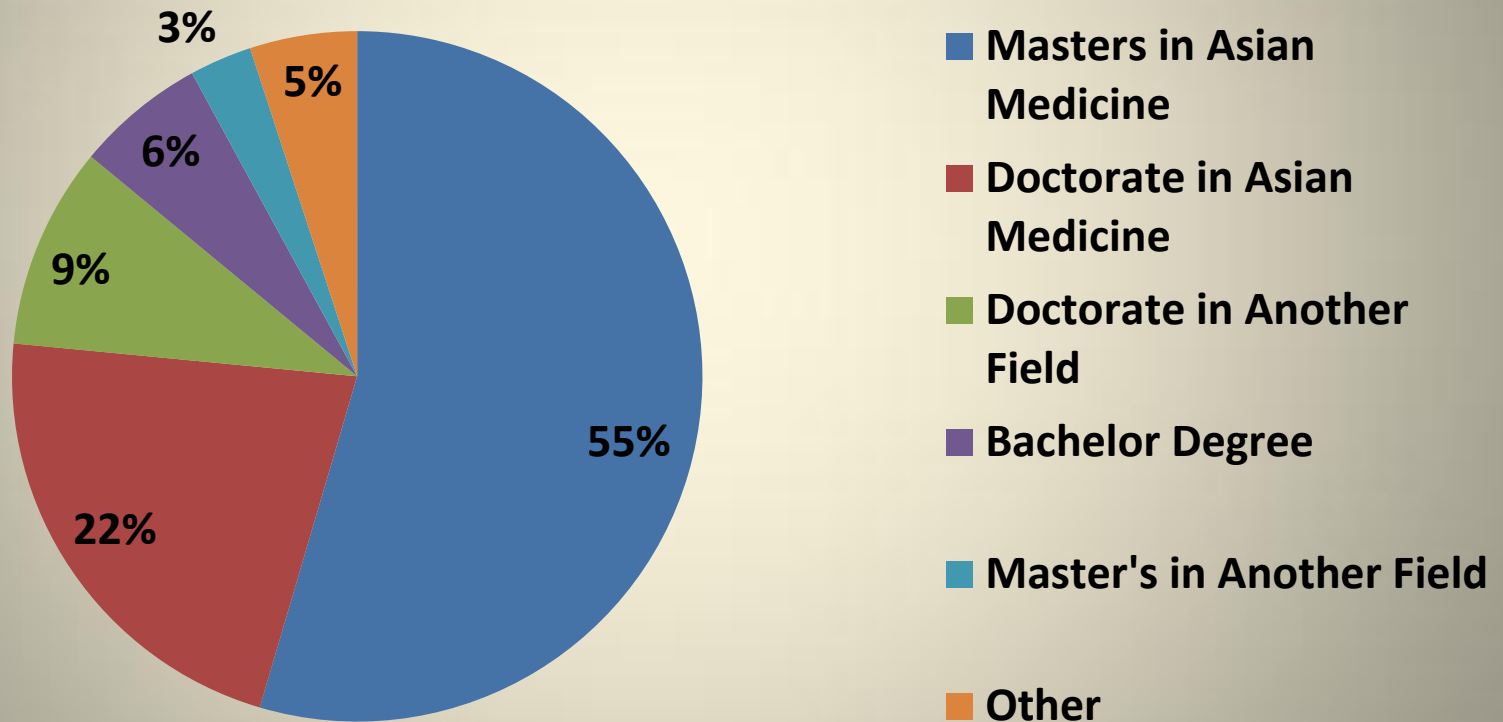

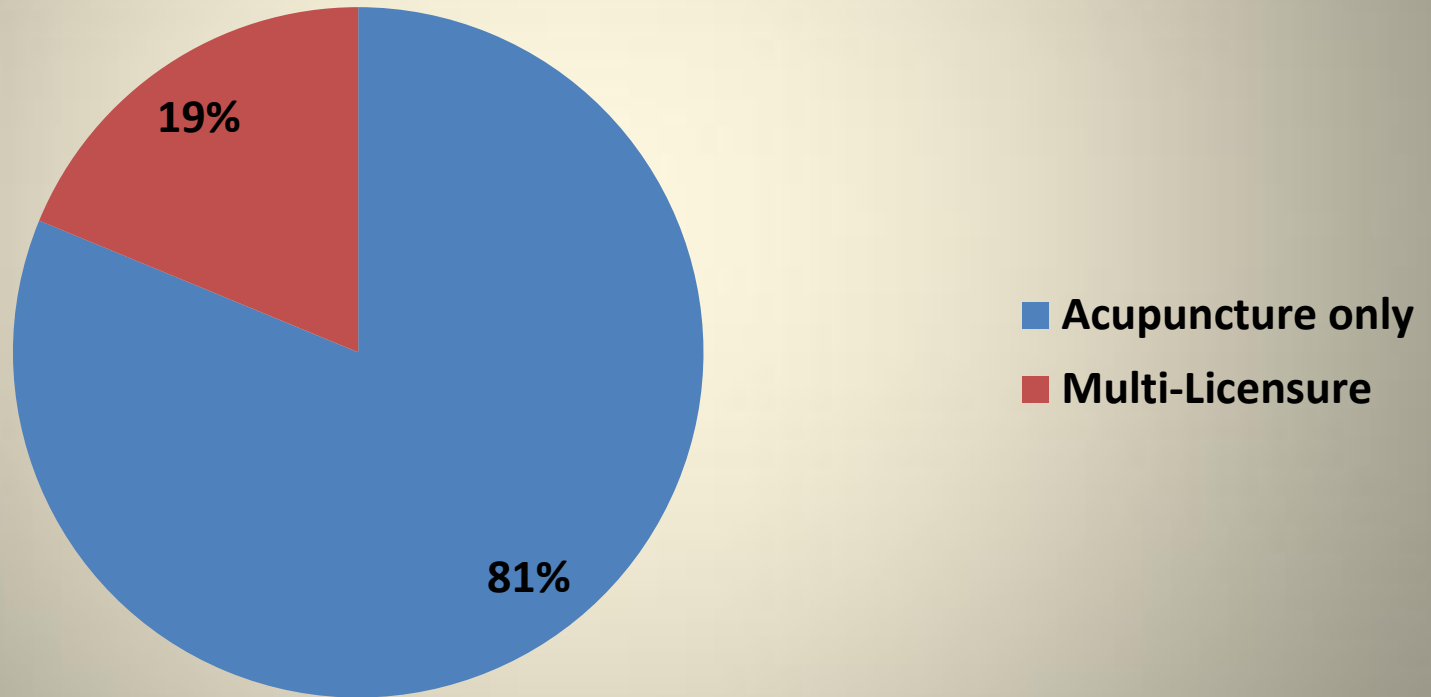

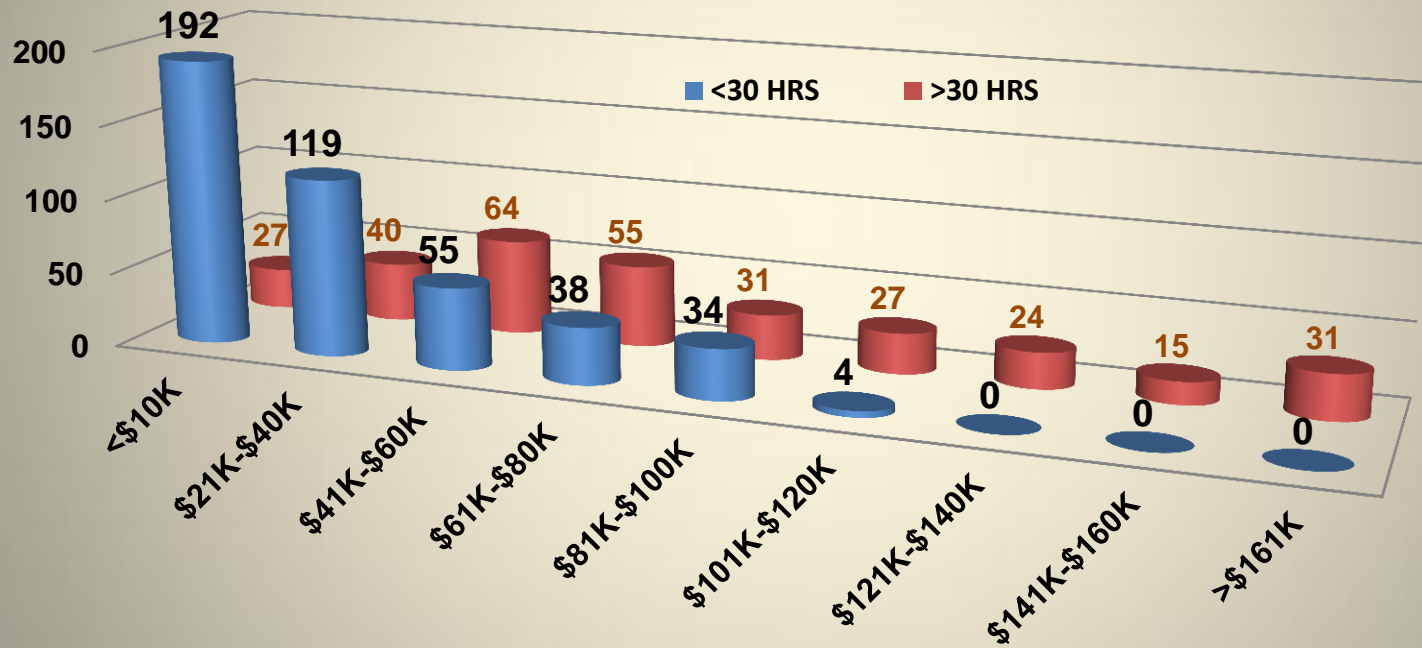

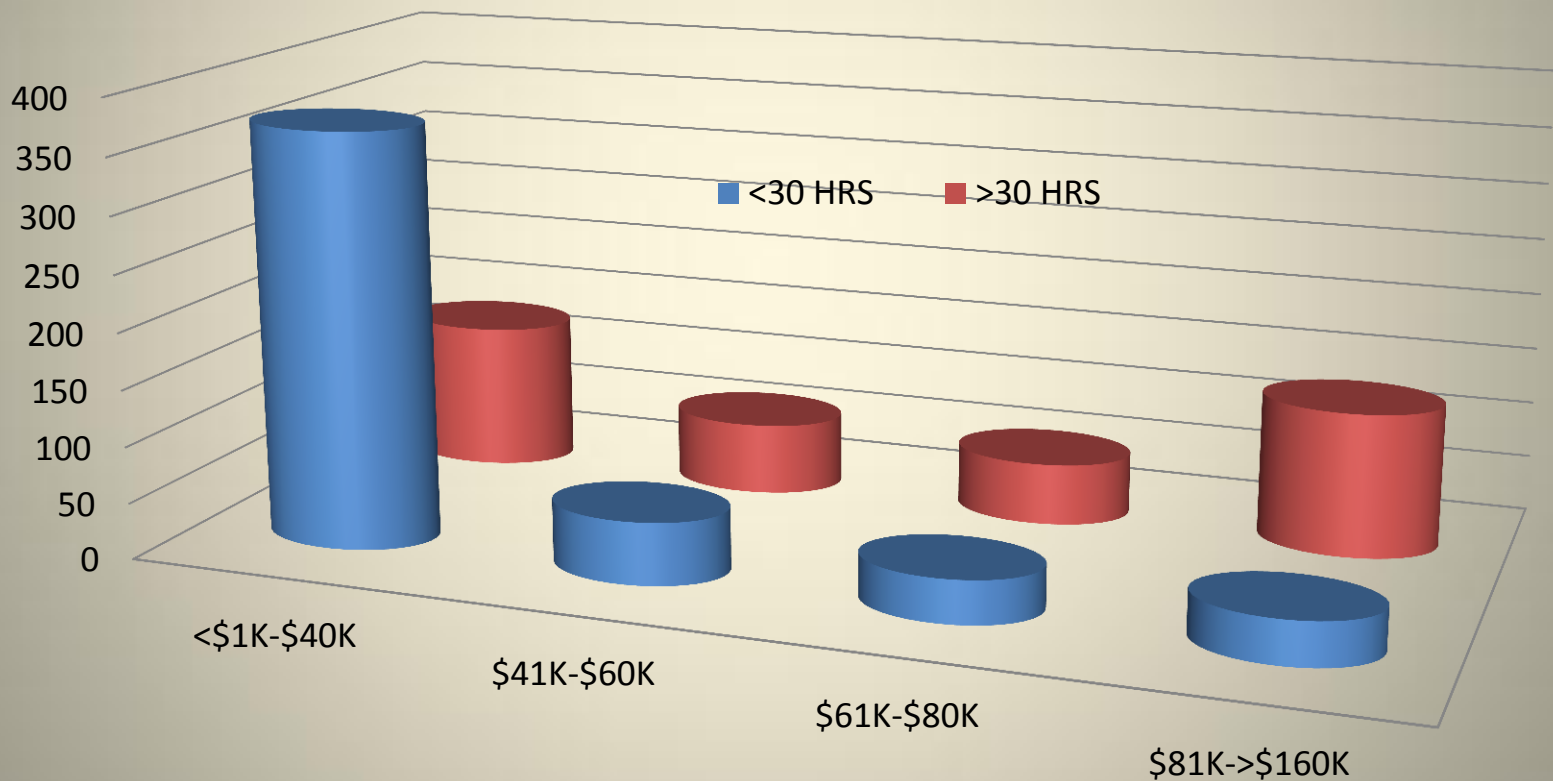
# National Acupuncture Workforce: Income by Time Worked

Figure 1: LAc Income Distribution by Deciles: NCCAOM 2010



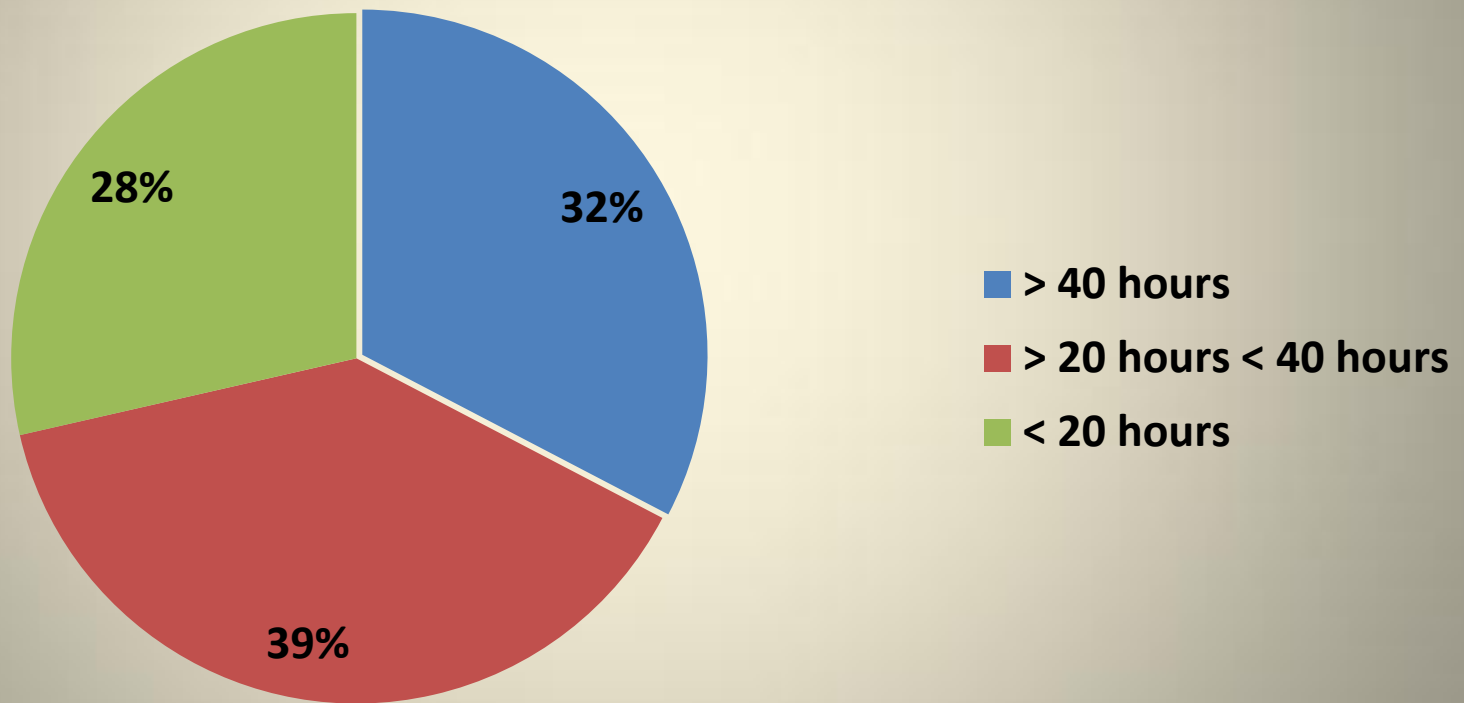

# California Workforce: Average Hours Worked

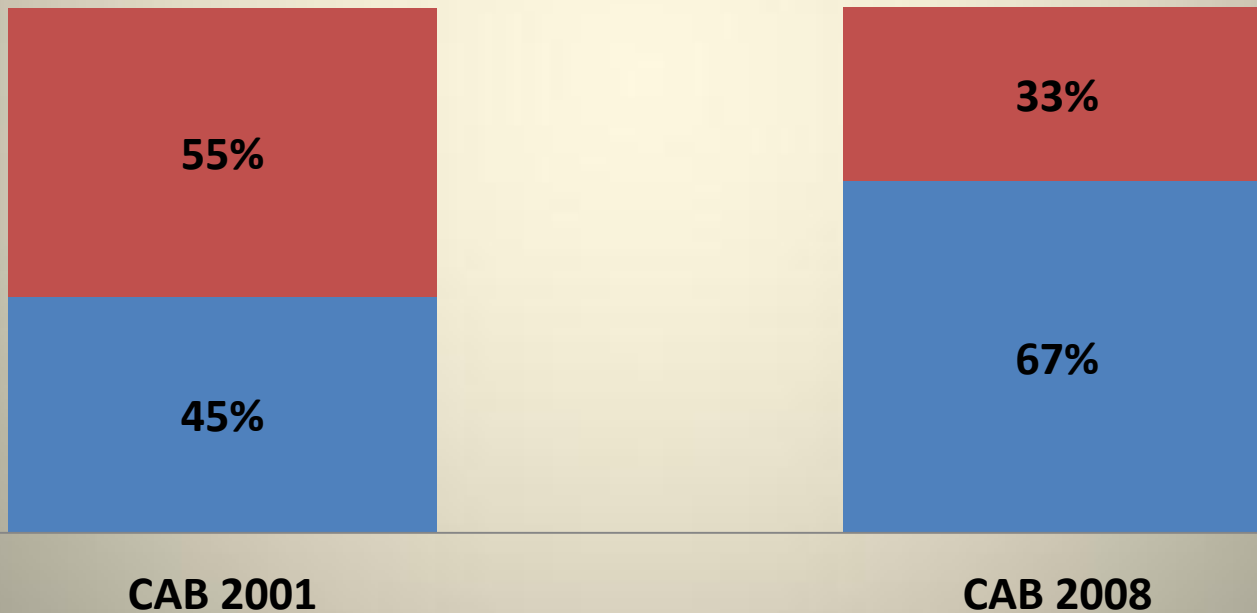

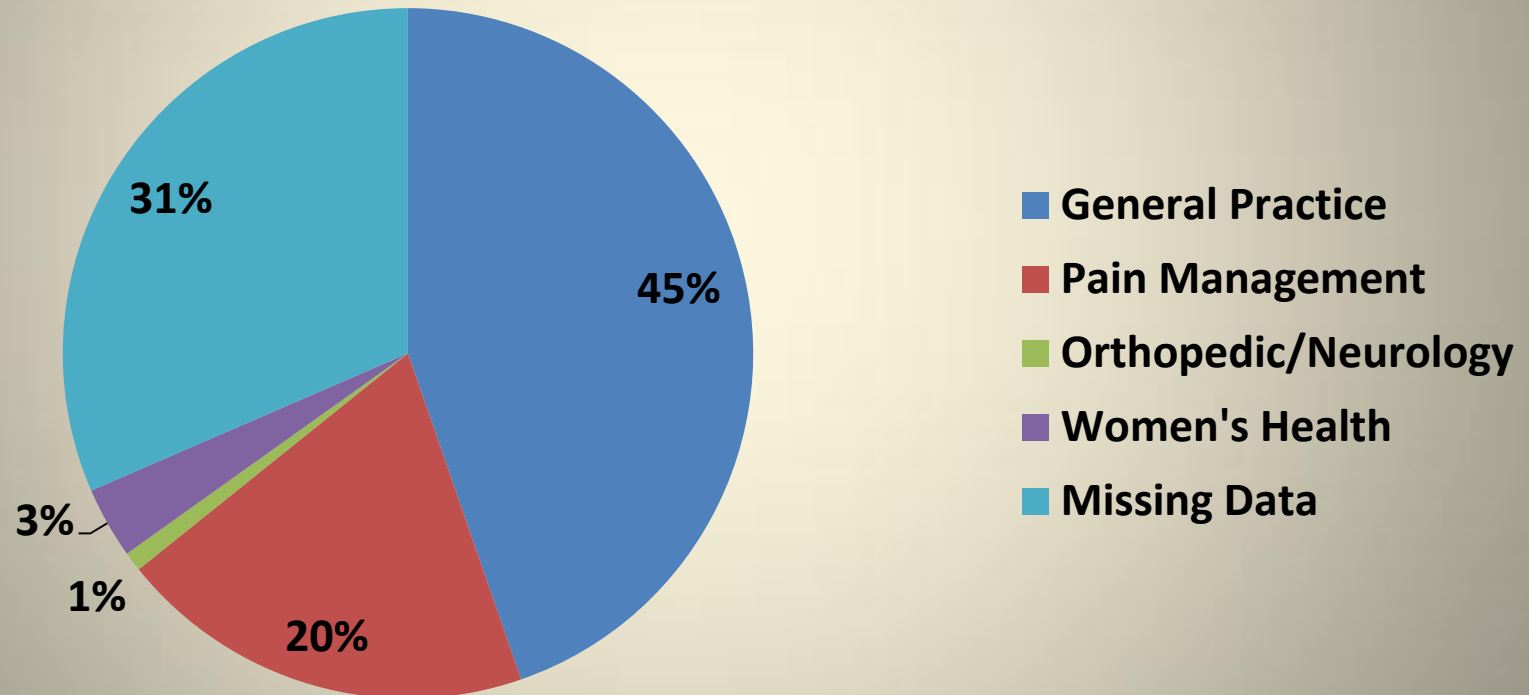

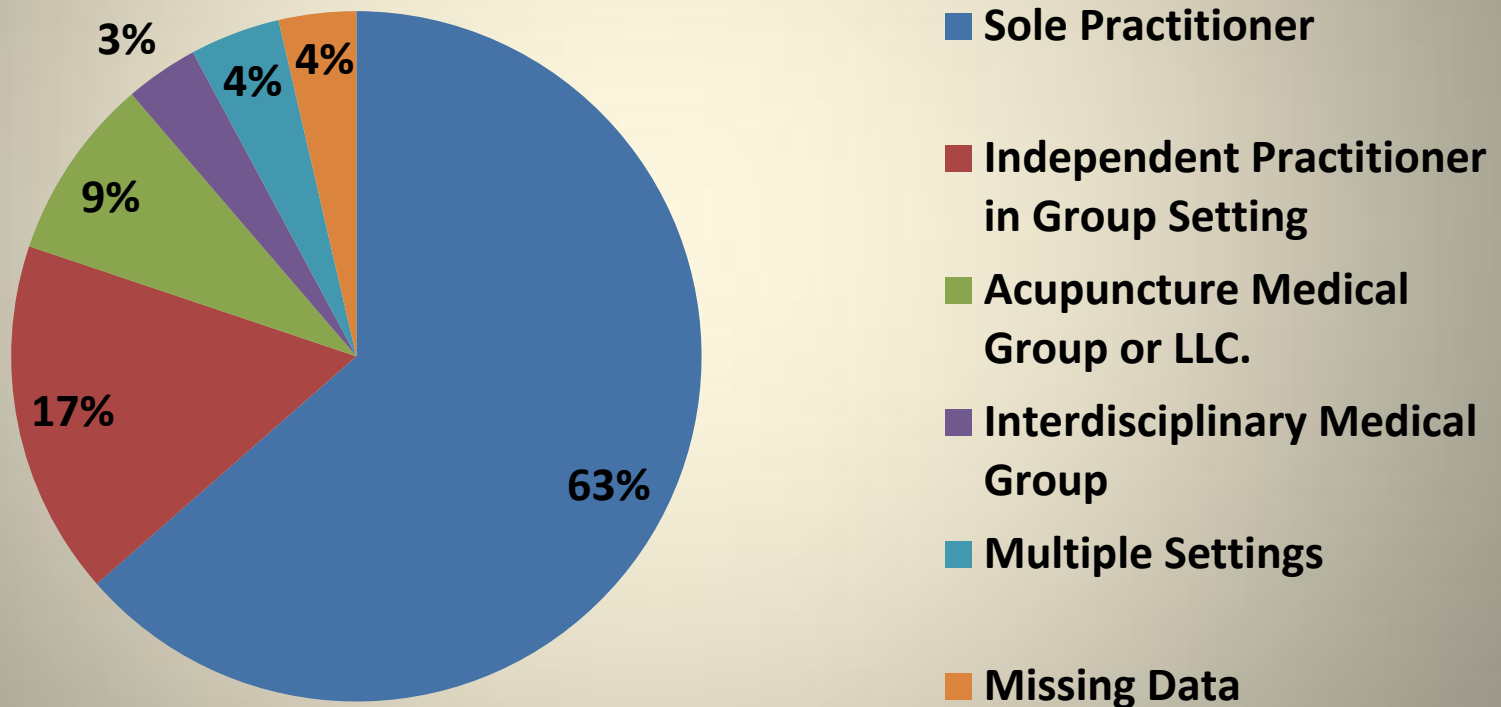
## Primary Focus of Practice

# California Acupuncture Profession

## Quick Facts

- One-third of all Licensed Acupuncturists are in California.
- 20%-25% of all Licensed Acupuncturists are Asian.
- 40% of all Asian Licensed Acupuncturists are in California.
- Average gross income is approximately \$50,000.
- Average debt is approximately \$45,000.

# Acupuncture Quick Facts (cont.)

- 50% of acupuncturists work less than 30 hours per week.
- 50% of acupuncturists earn less than \$50,000 (gross).
- 90% of acupuncturists work independently.

# 2008 California Occupational Analysis

## Demographics

- 63% sole practitioners
- 46% licensed 0-5 years
- 38% worked 21-39 hours per week
- 44% general practice focus
- 89% English proficiency
- 81% speak English fluently
- 70% have patients whose primary language is English
- 76% felt training program prepared them
