

**STIPULATED SETTLEMENT AND  
DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

17 **IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED** by and between the parties to the above-  
18 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

19 **PARTIES**

21 1. Terri A. Thorfinnson (Complainant) is the Executive Officer of the Acupuncture  
22 Board. She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in this matter by  
23 Kamala D. Harris, Attorney General of the State of California, by Catherine E. Santillan, Senior  
24 Legal Analyst.  
25 2. DONG MEI LI (Respondent) is represented by attorney Ann H. Larson of  
26 McNamara, Ney, Beatty, Slattery, Borges & Ambacher LLP 1211 Newell Avenue, Walnut Creek,  
27 CA 94596.  
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1 CULPABILITY

2 9. At an administrative hearing, Complainant could establish a prima facie case with  
3 respect to the allegations in First Amended Accusation No. 1A-2010-168, and Respondent  
4 therefore, subjects her license to discipline.

5 10. Respondent agrees to be bound by the Board's probationary terms as set forth in the  
6 Disciplinary Order below.

7 CONTINGENCY

8 11. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Acupuncture Board. Respondent  
9 understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Acupuncture Board may  
10 communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to  
11 or participation by Respondent. By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees  
12 that she may not withdraw her agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the  
13 Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and  
14 Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for  
15 this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall  
16 not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.

17 12. The parties understand and agree that facsimile copies of this Stipulated Settlement  
18 and Disciplinary Order, including facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and  
19 effect as the originals.

20 13. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that  
21 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following  
22 Disciplinary Order:

23 DISCIPLINARY ORDER

24 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Acupuncture License No. AC 5809 issued to DONG MEI  
25 LI (Respondent) is revoked. However, the revocation is stayed and Respondent is placed on  
26 probation for two (2) years on the following terms and conditions:

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1. REIMBURSEMENT FOR PROBATION SURVEILLANCE MONITORING

Respondent shall reimburse the Board for the hourly costs it incurs in monitoring the probation to ensure compliance for the duration of the probation period.

2. COURSEWORK Respondent shall take and successfully complete not less than twenty (20) additional hours of continuing education or the equivalent of twenty (20) hours in a graduate level program to be approved by the Board in the area of medical record keeping and/or ethics, or an alternative course to be approved by the board. Course content shall be pertinent to the violation and all coursework must be completed within the first two (2) years of probation. The required coursework must be in addition to any continuing education courses that may be required for license renewal.

Within ninety (90) days of the effective date of this decision, respondent shall submit a plan for the Board's prior approval for meeting the educational requirements. All costs of the coursework shall be borne by the respondent.


3. OBEY ALL LAWS Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws and all regulations governing the practice of acupuncture in California. A full and detailed account of any and all violations of law shall be reported by the respondent to the Board in writing within seventy-two (72) hours of occurrence.

4. QUARTERLY REPORTS Respondent shall submit quarterly declarations under penalty of perjury on forms provided by the Board, stating whether there has been compliance with all the conditions of probation.


5. SURVEILLANCE PROGRAM Respondent shall comply with the Board's probation surveillance program and shall, upon reasonable notice, report to the assigned investigative district office. Respondent shall contact the assigned probation surveillance monitor regarding any questions specific to the probation order. Respondent shall not have any unsolicited or unapproved contact with 1) victims or complainants associated with the case; 2) Board members or members of its staff; or 3) persons serving the Board as expert examiners.
