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17	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-	
18	entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:	
19	PARTIES	
20	1. Terri Thorfinnson ("Complainant") is the Executive Officer of the Acupuncture	
21	Board. She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in this matter by	
22	Kamala D. Harris, Attorney General of the State of California, by Claudia Ramirez, Deputy	
23	Attorney General.	
24	2. Karen Gao, L.Ac. ("Respondent") is represented in this proceeding by attorney	
25	Michael Bruggeman, Esq., whose address is The Law Office of Michael Bruggeman, 1201 Dove	
26	Street, Suite 560, Newport Beach, California, 92660.	
27	3. On or about July 3, 2002, the Acupuncture Board issued Acupuncturist's License No.	
28	AC 8509 to Respondent. That license was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the	
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Stipulated Surrender of License (Case No. 1A-2010-102)

charges brought in Accusation No. 1A-2010-102 and will expire on October 31, 2015, unless 1 renewed. 2 JURISDICTION 3 4. Accusation No. 1A-2010-102 was filed before the Acupuncture Board ("Board"), 4 Department of Consumer Affairs, and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation 5 and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on December 6 16, 2013. Respondent timely filed her Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy of 7 Accusation No. 1A-2010-102 is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by reference. 8 9 ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS 5. Respondent has carefully read, fully discussed with counsel, and understands the 10 charges and allegations in Accusation No. 1A-2010-102. Respondent also has carefully read, 11 fully discussed with counsel, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Surrender of License 12 and Order. 13 Respondent is fully aware of her legal rights in this matter, including the right to a 6. 14 hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel, at 15 her own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against her; the right to 16 present evidence and to testify on her own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to 17 compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration 18 and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California 19 Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws. 20 7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and 21 every right set forth above. 22 23 CULPABILITY 8. Respondent does not contest that, at an administrative hearing, Complainant could 24 establish a prima facie case with respect to the charges and allegations contained in Accusation 25 No. 1A-2010-102 and that she has thereby subjected her license to disciplinary action. 26 9. Respondent agrees that if she ever petitions for reinstatement of her Acupuncture 27 28 License No. AC8509, all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 1A-2010102 shall be deemed true, correct and fully admitted by Respondent for purposes of that
 reinstatement proceeding or any other licensing proceeding involving Respondent in the State of
 California.

10. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation she enables the Board to issue an order accepting the surrender of her Acupuncturist's License without further process.

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CONTINGENCY

11. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Acupuncture Board. Respondent 7 understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Acupuncture Board may 8 communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and surrender, without notice to or 9 participation by Respondent or her counsel. By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands 10 and agrees that she may not withdraw her agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the 11 time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its 12 Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or 13 effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, 14 and the Board shall not be disgualified from further action by having considered this matter. 15

16 12. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile
17 copies of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, including Portable Document Format
18 (PDF) and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

19 13. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
20 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order:

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ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Acupuncturist's License No. AC 8509, issued to
 Respondent Karen Gao, L.Ac., is surrendered and accepted by the Acupuncture Board.

The surrender of Respondent's Acupuncturist's License and the acceptance of the
 surrendered license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent.
 This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent's
 license history with the Acupuncture Board.

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2.

Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as an Acupuncturist in California as of

the effective date of the Be	oard's Decision and O	rder.
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Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Board her wall certificate and, if one
 was issued, her pocket license on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.

4 4. If Respondent ever files an application for licensure or a petition for reinstatement in
5 the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a petition for reinstatement. Respondent must
6 comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for reinstatement of a revoked license in
7 effect at the time the petition is filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in
8 Accusation No. 1A-2010-102 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent
9 when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the petition.

10 5. Respondent shall pay the Board its costs of investigation and enforcement in the
amount of \$20,544.00 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.

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ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the above Stipulated Surrender of License and Order and have fully
discussed it with my attorney, Michael Bruggeman, Esq. I understand the stipulation and the
effect it will have on my Acupuncturist's License. I enter into this Stipulated Surrender of
License and Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the
Decision and Order of the Acupuncture Board.
